Bug Repelling Mason Jar Lumineers

Ingredients

- 4 oz of beeswax
- cotton wicks
- 10-20 drops essential oils
- small silicon molds
- quart-size mason jar
- lemon, sliced
- lime, sliced
- rosemary sprigs

Directions

1. To make the floating candles, you will need to melt the beeswax in a double boiler.
2. Once melted, remove the pot from the heat and mix in the essential oils. Pour the melted wax into the silicon molds.
3. Allow the wax to cool slightly before adding in the wicks (the top layer of the wax will be somewhat dry and will hold the wicks in place).
4. Let the mini candles cool before popping out of the mold.
5. Place the rosemary, sliced lemons, and limes in the mason jar.
6. Add 4-6 drops of citronella essential oil and fill the jar with water, leaving 1-1 1/2 inches of space at the top.
7. Place a floating candle on the top of the water.
8. Light the candle and enjoy!
